The proper way to greet a priest or Bishop is to ask his blessings and kiss his right hand, placing your right hand over your Left hand and say "Father" or "Master" in the case of the bishop, bless. He will make the sign of the cross and place his right hand over yours. When you kiss their hands, you show respect for their office they are the ones who "bless and Sanctify" you and who offer the Holy gifts on your behalf.

So next time you greet your priest or Bishop, don't shake his hand, ask for his blessings. Also, it has been the custom in orthodox countries.
